Emergency Responses by Type:









Response Time - EMS

Significant Incidents:

Round Lake Crews were dispatched to 11 structure fires in January. Of these, 6 were in-district and 1 was significant.

Monday, January 16th @ 3:08 pm (Red):

Crews were dispatched to the 1600 block of N. Juneway Terrace in Round Lake Beach for a report of a garage on fire. E262 arrived on scene within 3 minutes and reported a working fire with smoke and flames showing in a single-story detached garage. They advanced an attack line and attempted to make entry through the man door but determined that the roof was unstable and changed strategy to a defensive attack. B26 arrived, assumed command, and upgraded the alarm to the working still level to bring in resources to cover the rest of the Fire District. E262R arrived next, established a positive water supply for E262 and assisted with the fire attack.

The fire was brought under control in approximately 30 minutes and there were no injuries to civilians or firefighters.

Our crews were assisted by crews from Antioch, Fox Lake, Grayslake, Lake Villa, and Wauconda. During the fire, calls in the remainder of the District were covered by Antioch and McHenry.
